WHERE: Misty Meadows in Triangle Lake, Oregon

WHEN: August 14-16, 2020 (Fri-Sun)

COST: **\$10 per person age 3 and over.**

Maximum \$50 per family if paid by Sunday, August 9.

If paid after August 9, cost increases to \$15 per person age 3 and over. Maximum \$75 per family.

SLEEPING

FOOD

This year because of Covid-19, all meals will be on your own, with none of them provided.

BATHROOMS

SCHEDULE

Arrive Friday any time after daybreak. Family Camp is officially over after Sunday worship by the river but families are welcome to stay through Monday if they wish. Masks are not required for outside events in Oregon, but please use proper social distancing guidelines to the best of your ability throughout the weekend.

MAP TO MISTY MEADOWS

Average Trip Time: 3 hours or less

DIRECTIONS

- ◆ **I-5 South:** I-5 south through Salem and Albany.
- ◆ **Exit 216 Halsey Brownsville:** About 20 miles south of Albany take Exit #216 Halsey Brownsville and go right at the stop sign.
- ◆ **HWY 228 west 2 miles:** You are now going west on HWY 228. Go 2 miles to Halsey and turn left on HWY 99 at the flashing red light.
- ◆ **HWY 99 south 15 miles:** Take HWY 99 south **through** Harrisburg and **through** Junction City. Two miles after Junction City turn right on HWY 36 at the stoplight.
- ◆ **HWY 36 west 28 miles:** Take HWY 36 west for about 28 miles. After about 25 miles look for Memorial Community Church on the left. Look for the EBC sign on the left 3.1 miles past the church. Follow the gravel driveway down and then across the big field to the campground. Welcome!
